MEET DETAILS

Hoot-N-Holler Sprint Invitational

Saturday, October 25th, 2025

- Warm-Ups begin at 7:30AM - Assigned lanes will be sent Monday, October 20th
- Meet will begin at 9:00AM
- Diving will begin following the completion of swimming events

LOCATION

YMCA of the Highland Lakes - 1601 S. Water Street, Burnet, TX 78611

Parking located on site - Please park all buses in the back of the YMCA

POOLS

Competition Pool:

All events will be completed in our 10 lane, 25 yard Competition Pool. Warm-Up and Cooldown pre- and post-meet will be available in the Competition Pool.

Therapeutic Pool:

Warming up and cooling down during the meet will be allowed during the meet in the shallow, therapeutic pool. Note that this pool is heated, so best judgement is advised when using it.

Diving is strictly prohibited in the Therapeutic Pool.

WARM-UPS

Teams will be sent an official time for team warm-ups. During this time the two furthest outside lanes will be open for practicing starts.

Warming-up and cooling down during the meet will be limited to the Therapeutic Pool.

SPECTATORS

There will be no entry fee for spectators.

Spectators are asked to stay in the spectator seating area. Spectators are prohibited from team seating.

Per UIL rules, artificial noise makers are prohibited from the competition. No flash photography is allowed during diving events for the safety of our athletes.

SEEDING

The meet will be a Timed Finals, seeded slowest to fastest. Swimmers entered with no time will be seeded in the slowest heat. No proof of time is required.

ENTRIES

All entries must be sent via email to cmcburnett@burnetcisd.net using the Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager software.

- Per UIL rules, athletes will be limited to a maximum of 4 events, with no more than 2 individual events.
- Teams may enter an A Relay and B Relay, but only the A Relays will be scored
- Teams are limited to 6 individuals in a single event, with a maximum of 4 scored in a single event.

ENTRY DEADLINE

The Hy-Tek entry file must be submitted to cmcburnett@burnetcisd.net **no later than October 20th, 2025 by 3:00PM.**

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are \$12 per athlete entered and a \$12 fee per relay. Entry fees are due at the start of competition.

EVENTS

The Hoot-N-Holler is a tradition for Burnet Swim and Dive. It is a sprint invitational with shorter events than normal and Halloween themed relays. This invitational serves as a chance for athletes to compete and show off their top-end speed, while also providing a fun atmosphere in celebration for the season.

The events are as follows:

- 100 Witches Hat and Broom Relay: A four-person relay where athletes must make it across the pool with a witches hat and broom in hand. Any stroke is allowed.
- 200 Free
- 100 IM
- 50 Free
- 50 Fly
- 100 Free
- 500 Free
- 100 Sweater Relay: A four-person relay where each athlete will swim a 25 freestyle wearing a sweater. The athlete can not dive in until the sweater has been put on.
- 50 Back
- 50 Breast
- 200 Free Relay

There will be a 5 minute break after the first relay, 50 Free, 500 Free, and the 100 Breast.

SCORING

Top sixteen in each event will be scored.

Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relays: Double the score of an individual event.

AWARDS

There will be no awards at this meet.

RULES AND SANCTIONS

The 2025-2026 National Federation of State High School Associations Swimming and Diving and all UIL rules and guidelines will be applied.

TIMING SYSTEM

A Colorado electronic timing system with Daktronics electric scoreboard will be used to time the meet. Two watches per lane will be used as back up.

TIMERS

We ask that each team has one timer or volunteer available for the meet.

AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, restrooms, showers, or locker rooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event. Also, flash photography is not permitted during all the diving events as this is unsafe for the athletes.

DECK CHANGING PROHIBITION

Changing in or out of swimsuits in areas other than locker rooms or designated areas is strictly prohibited. Athletes will have access to changing rooms, showers, and restrooms at the YMCA.

CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be available in the lobby of the YMCA.

HOSPITALITY

A hospitality table will be available for meet officials and coaches near the scorers table.
