Invitational Relay Rumble Meet

- Welcome:**
- Saint John Paul II and Steel High Schools invite you to join us at Schertz YMCA, 4 Jan 2025 for the first annual Relay Rumble. This is a small teams invite for teams with less than 30 swimmers and in TAPPS Division I-III (district 2). If outside Division and District, contact the meet director for an exception.
- Venue:**
- Schertz YMCA, 621 Westchester Dr, Schertz, TX 78154.
- Facility:**
- **25 Yard Indoor Pool – Eight Lanes (6 Competition Lanes)** (2.75-meter) lanes. automated timing system (note: swimmers need to touch the timing pad on the front, NOT top). If technical difficulties prevent the use of the automated timing system, duel timers will be used. Concessions stand will Not be available. No shaving anywhere at the facility. Spectator Bleacher seating is limited.
 - Hy-Tek Meet Manager software and automated timing system.
- Rules:**
- The 2024-2025 National Federation of Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo Rules will govern this meet.
- Entry Restrictions:**
- Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 events
 - Teams are limited to 2 Relay teams per Relay event. except for the 200 Freestyle relay, and 100 kickboard relay, teams may enter 3 relay teams for these events
 - Meet will be capped at 250 swimmers or 10 teams.
- Meet Format:**
- All events are timed finals.
 - Nominal 30 seconds between heats.
 - Federation Whistle Start and No Recall False Start Procedures will be used.
 - Fly-over starts may be utilized.
 - Break after event 10. Additional breaks as required.
 - No penalty for missing an event.
- Relays:**
- Relay only swimmers ARE permitted as this is a relays only event
 - Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are permitted to report to the blocks and compete.
 - If relay swimmers are to be correctly noted in Final Results, order of swimming must also be specified
 - Relay cards for all relays must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the beginning of the coaches' meeting.
 - Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, *no name changes will be permitted.*
 - Designation of the lead-off swimmer may be altered up until the swimmers report to the blocks.
 - Post-meet corrections or alterations cannot be made.

Entry Deadline:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Entries will be capped at 250 swimmers. ● Entries close Tuesday, Dec 31st, 2024 at 6:00 PM. no changes are permitted after the heat sheets have been generated.
Entries:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 total events. ● For all relay events, teams are limited to 2 entries per event. ● When submitting files to the Entries Chair, please include the name, email address, and the phone number of the person submitting the entries. ● Entries must be emailed to Paul Patillo, ppatillo@johnpaul2chs.org ● If you do not receive an email confirmation, your entries were not received ● Please do not use any other email address for submitting your entries!!! ● Entries may be submitted ONLY by Hy-Tek file. Hard copy must accompany each entry and must include the swimmer's full name, swimmer's school affiliation, grade and seed time. Entries received without a seed time will be allowed however, to ensure your swimmer is seeded appropriately, please provide an estimate. Include entry HYV file, entry report, and entry fee report when submitting your entries.

Scoring:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Relay points: 30 26 24 22 20 18 16 14 10 6 (only top 2 relays will be scored)
Officials:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All deck officials must be currently registered and tested with NFHS for the 2024-2025 season. ● Uniform is white collared shirt or blouse with khaki trousers, Bermuda-length shorts, skirts. ● Please contact the Meet Referee before 18 October 2022 so he can plan accordingly.

Cell phone**Restrictions:**

- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the blocks.
- There are no exceptions to this policy
- Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility, and arrest.

Swimmer**Photographs****And Videos:**

- There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet
- In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.
- Photographers and videographers must stay out of the area immediately behind the starting blocks.

Deck**Changing:**

Deck changing is prohibited

Special Needs:

- Please notify the meet director of any special needs of your swimmers.
- Team seating may be outdoors depending on need, severe weather protocols will be in effect
- Team will need to bring Ez-Ups and chairs for outdoor seating

Mixed relays will consist of 2 boys and 2 girls, they can swim in any order

100 Kickboard Relay will be an exhibition event girls event and boys event, no points awarded, it does count towards 5 events. Both hands must remain on the kickboard until it touches the wall, the swimmer will exit the water and hand off the kickboard to the next swimmer who will enter water feet first.

Backstroke relay: first swimmer will leave from backstroke blocks, other relay swimmers will leave from the blocks as the swimmer touches, and must roll to their back before the first stroke is taken.

Breast to fly relay will alternate between breaststroke and butterfly (1, 3 breast, 2, 4 fly)

100 sweatshirt relay is a mixed exhibition event, not points awarded it does count towards 5 events
